WHAT IS SPECIAL OLYMPICS?

Barron County Special Olympics is a year round sports program providing athletes with an opportunity to learn skills, build friendships, and have fun in a family friendly environment.

WHAT ARE THE ELIGEBILITY REQUIREMENTS?

Athletes must be 8 years old to compete. Athletes must have a diagnosis of intellectual disabilities or closely related developmental disability. Athletes must have a current physical on file with the state before beginning practice.

HOW DO I REGISTER OR LEARN MORE ABOUT THE PROGRAM?

Athletes must complete a physical form every 3 years and a one-time release form. Forms can be found on-line at specialolympicswisconsin.org under "Get Involved" and then "Become on athlete" or by contacting Mary Ebner at 715-651-7439. Physicals must be completed prior to practicing. If interested in a specific sport, see the physical deadline dates per sport below in "General Information." These are the dates in which the physical MUST be into the state office.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Athletes may participate in any sports which interest them.
- Physicals are good for 3 years and apply to all sports. A current physical must be into the state by the following dates to participate: Bowling Oct. 1; Basketball February 1; Swimming @ Track/Field April 1; Softball/ T-Ball June 1
- If attending state, the program requests \$35.00 to help off-set registration fees. (\$35.00 covers transportation, housing, meals, registration) No athlete is denied participation due to economic circumstances!
- Uniforms are provided. Athletes may opt to provide their own black shorts (requirements will be provided)
- Competition is based on individual/team abilities and age. Athletes compete against those within 10% of their times, distances, skill scores, etc. and age range.
- Athlete and family t-shirts are available for those interested. Information will be available at the start of each sport season.
- Athlete transportation is provided (free of charge) to Regional and State competitions.
