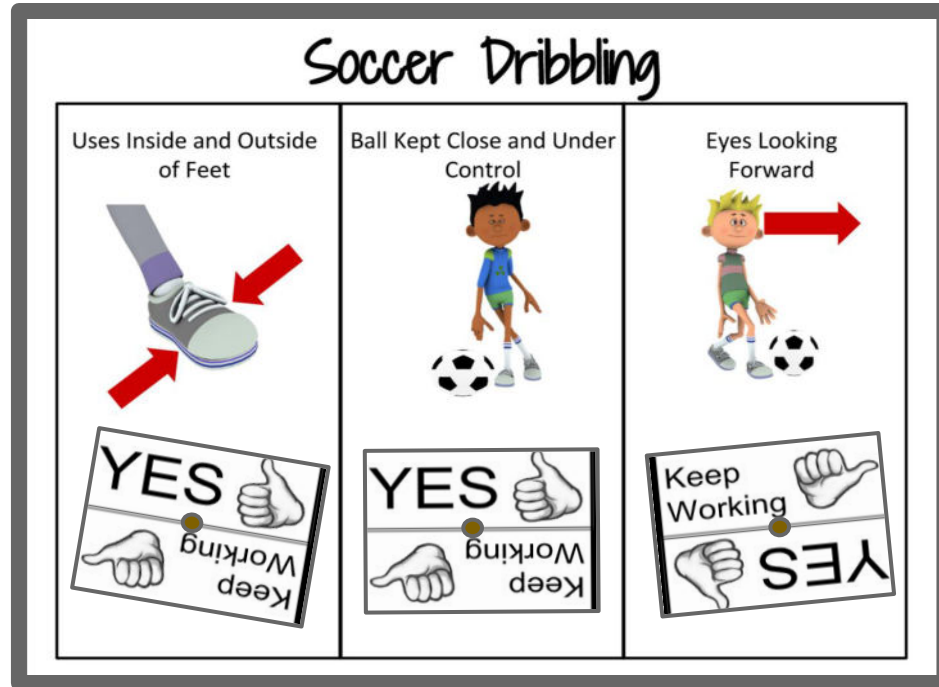


# Spin Peer Assessment

# Getting Started

- ★ Edit the assessment by clicking each label on slide 3 to add your custom cues (labels appear when slide 3 is open for editing).
  - ★ Title= Skill name
  - ★ Subtitle= Skill cues
  - ★ The light grey boxes are guides for sizing any images you may be adding. If no images are added, they can be deleted and the text size for the skill cues can be increased.
- ★ Cut out the *Yes/Still Working* text boxes, and using a paper fastener attach one below each cue onto the front sheet of the dry erase pocket (they can also be added directly to the assessment paper).
  - ★ Laminating the text boxes before attaching the fastener will make it more durable.
- ★ These cards have been used as a peer assessment during stations, game play, or while practicing during an activity.

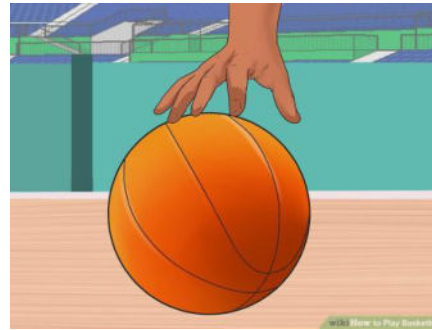
