About the Scholarship

The Beatrice Lane Memorial Scholarship was established to honor the memory of Beatrice Lane. Beatrice, who served the banking industry for 74 years, was the oldest and longest serving employee of South Central Bank. Throughout her impressive career, she served the bank with dignity, loyalty, and pride.

Each year, South Central Bank will award a \$1,500.00 scholarship to a promising high school senior, who is a resident of the Tompkinsville/Monroe County Community, to assist with costs in attending the college of their choice.

Criteria & Application

To be considered for the Scholarship applicants may be attending any public or private school within Monroe County. Well-rounded high school seniors who have demonstrated a strong work ethic toward their academics and are involved in a healthy balance of extracurricular & community service activities are encouraged to apply.

Awarding of the Beatrice Lane Memorial Scholarship is contingent on several criteria including acceptance to and enrollment in a two- or four-year accredited institution, and a completed application. Additionally, applicants are required to submit a 1,000 word essay demonstrating their passion to create a better world. Scholarship recipients are expected to use their resources wisely and uphold a high standard of conduct.

How to Apply

Your complete application, including all attachments, can be submitted electronically.

Incomplete or late applications cannot be considered.

Completed applications will be reviewed by members of the Scholarship Committee. Selection will be based on a student's commitment to service in our community, overall academic progress and involvement in extracurricular activities.

Applicants will be notified by email of any scholarship award or denial on or before May 6.

**Application Requirements**

Completed application with required attachments by April 26. Official high school transcript showing a GPA of at least 3.0.

A brief description of planned area of study and career goals

An essay must accompany your application. It must be typed, double spaced using 12 point.

Essay Question: Please describe how you, as an adult, will strive to help create a better world. This can be through field of study, or personal commitment.
