Bisa Butler Portraits



- 1. Observe the artworks of Bisa Butler and her colorful quilted portraits in class and individually.
- 2. Plan and prepare a color scheme in your sketchbooks using values and tones to add depth to the final artwork.
- 3. Research photographs of someone important to you, choose a photograph with good lighting to show shadows and highlights.
- 4. Posterize the image, soften the edges, and print an 8x10 photo copy of the printed image.
- 5. Using tracing paper, trace all of the shapes in the photo. Label each shape on both the tracing paper and the photo.
- 6. Choose a unique color scheme to represent the person of the portrait, keeping in mind which colors will be for lights, mediums, and dark tones.
- 7. Utilize the entire composition by filling up the entire space.
- 8. Glue the background fabrics first.
- 9. Cut out the shapes on the tracing paper and trace the shapes onto desired fabrics, then cut the fabric shapes out.
- 10. Glue each shape down on top of the background and build the portrait.
- 11. Use your color scheme, compositional space, patterns, and neatness to design the finished artwork.
