

Choose a reading, writing, and math activity to do. Don't worry about crossing it off after you have finished. You can do these activities multiple times!

Reading	Writing	Math
Create a fort and invite a friend or family member to join you while you read aloud to them.	Write a letter to a community helper thanking them for their service/job that they do.	Create your own addition or subtraction flashcards (at least 20) and practice them!
Read a story. Make a video of yourself retelling the story in under 2 minutes. Send it to a relative or your teacher.	Create a brand new food. You must name it and list all of the ingredients that are in it.	Plan a meal for your family. List all of the items, guess how much each costs, and then come up with a total for how much the meal costs.
Read the story, <u>"First Airplane Trip"</u> and answer the comprehension questions following the story.	Take your spelling words for the week, write them in shaving cream, do rainbow writing, or do ghost spelling (white crayon/marker on top)	Play a card or dice game with a family member. (Pig, Stuck in the mud, garbage, go fish, etc) <u>Directions</u>
Design a Map. Pick a scene from a book your read. Design a map that shows the space and includes all of the setting items.	Create a 2 or 4 line poem. Try to make the 1st/2nd lines rhyme and the 3rd/4th lines rhyme with each other. Example	Take a survey with people in your house asking them their favorite color or sport. Create a graph with the results. Example



Create a snow fort or structure outside with family members, daycare friends, or neighborhood buddies. Take a picture of the structure and send it to your teacher. Your teacher will share them during morning meeting tomorrow.
