0-4 Scale to Letter Grade Conversion Criteria

SCORE	DESCRIPTOR	GRADE	GRADE CONVERSION	What Does It Mean?
4	Advanced	A	<u>3.2 – 4.0</u> 3.2 – 3.44 = A 3.45 – 3.74 = A 3.75 – 4.0 = A+	An “A” letter grade would indicate that a student has mastered, at an advanced level, the academic learning targets for that class.
3	Proficient	B	<u>2.4 – 3.19</u> 2.4 – 2.64 = B 2.65 – 2.94 = B 2.95 – 3.19 = B+	A “B” letter grade would indicate that a student has a strong understanding of the content and has the tools needed to succeed at the next level.
2	Developing	C	<u>1.6 – 2.39</u> 1.6 – 1.84 = C 1.85 – 2.14 = C 2.15 – 2.39 = C+	A “C” letter grade would indicate that a student has the basic understanding of the content and skills needed for the course. They would have what is needed to move forward with their learning.
1	Beginning	D	<u>0.8 – 1.59</u> 0.8 – 1.04 = D 1.05 – 1.34 = D 1.35 – 1.59 = D+	A “D” letter grade would depict that a student has passed the course but not yet mastered the knowledge and skills necessary to succeed at the next level. This grade would communicate that future learning and intervention may be necessary.

0	Missing/Incomplete	F	0 – 0.79	An “F” letter grade would depict that a student has not yet mastered the knowledge and skills needed to move forward. This student would most likely need an intervention in order to be successful.
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
