- 6. The parties agree that Student B will attend an alternative education program at Transformation Learning beginning March 18, 2010, and throughout the period of exclusion.
- 7. The parties further agree that Student B will be on "Bad Standing" with the McGuffey School District through the end of 2009-2010 school year.
- 8. Student B must submit to a mental health evaluation by a licensed mental health facility and comply with its recommendation. Prior to readmission, a written verification that the mental health assessment and

- recommendation have been completed must be submitted to the high school administration. The parent or guardian assumes all cost and responsibilities relative to the assessment and recommendations.
- 9. Student B will be required to attend a school-based anger management support group during the remainder of the 2009-2010 school year and the first semester of the 2010-2011 school year.
- 10. Any violation of the aforesaid provisions shall result in a hearing before the board of education.
