## Memorandum of Recommendation October 16, 2023

RE: Recommendation for Approval of Temporary Power

**Connections** 

On August 3, 2023 the district advertised a Request for Proposals for the Temporary Power Connections project in the local publication, the Rochester Post, and posted RFP documents on the Purchasing pages of the district's website, Sigma, and BidNet Direct. The district received four (4) responses for one (1) category of construction trade on the due date. A public reading of bids received was conducted on September 26, 2023 at 2:00pm.

The scope of this project is to provide emergency power connections to a building so that a portable generator can be connected to a building in order to provide power to the kitchen walk-in coolers and freezers, in the event of a power failure. Providing these portable generator connections, will allow Facilities Maintenance to connect a portable generator to a building that has lost power, in lieu of relocating the food stored in the walk-in coolers or freezers, to another building until power is restored. These emergency power connections will be installed at the 10 buildings that currently do not have emergency power supply for the Kitchen walk-in coolers and freezers. The scope of the project also includes providing 3 portable generators to be utilized to provide temporary power until normal power is restored to the building(s) and is included in this funding request.

A future bid package, to provide the same emergency power connections for an additional 8 buildings, will be issued in the next few months, as these 8 buildings require more intensive work in order to provide a connection for a portable generator to connect to. The scope of this bid future package will necessitate replacing existing equipment, such as pumps and condensers, that feed the walk-in coolers and freezers. This work will allow this additional equipment to run on the same voltage as the walk-in coolers and freezers so they can be also powered by the generator as well.

Bids were reviewed and evaluated by a team from Frank Rewold and Son Inc., and by Pete Muscio, Director of Capital Projects for Rochester Community Schools. All of the accepted bids were found to be initially compliant with the required specifications per the detail in the bid summary. The bids were analyzed on bid content, completeness, inclusion of required submittals, and compliance with required specifications. Interviews and evaluations were conducted according to the attached documentation and recommendation submitted by Mike Gagnon of Frank Rewold & Son which was reviewed by Peter Muscio and Jennifer Fickel, Purchasing Supervisor.

The source of funding is the Food Service Fund.

Based on this information, we recommend **THAT the Board of Education award the following contracts to:**
