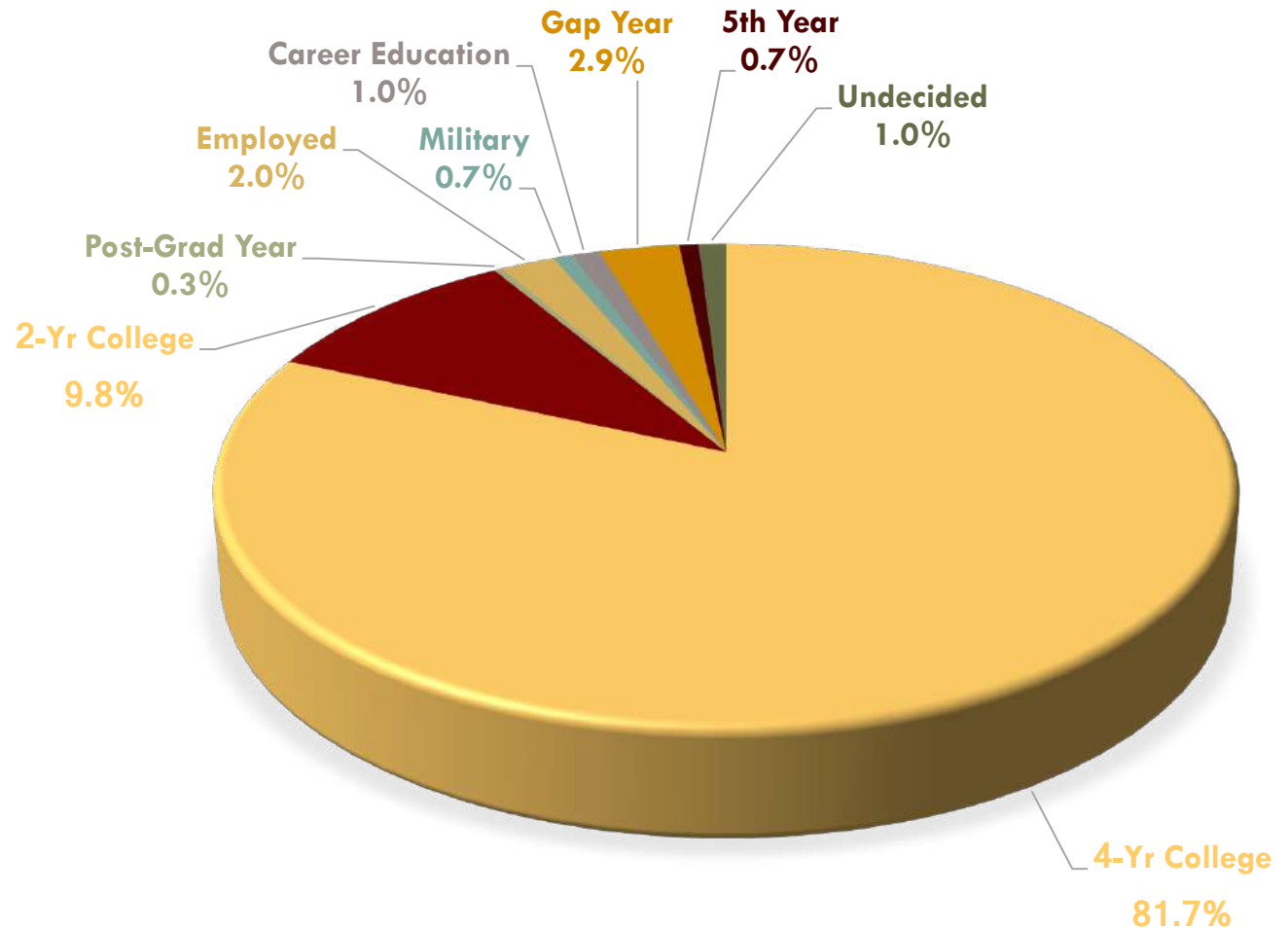

Barron's “Most Competitive” Placements

- ❑ 703 applications
- ❑ 243 MC acceptances (34.6% overall admit rate)
- ❑ 118 unique students received MC acceptance
- ❑ 101 students attending “Most Competitive” schools
 - ▣ 40.4% of 4-year college-bound
 - ▣ 36.1% of all college-bound
 - ▣ 33.0% of Class of 2018
- ❑ 105 students attend MC & HC+
 - ▣ 42.0% of 4-year college-bound
 - ▣ 37.5% of all college-bound



Why they don't choose “Most Competitive”

□ **16 students** chose other options for...

- Better financial aid
- Specific academic/honors programs
- Gap Year
- Location
- Campus life/atmosphere
- Social fit
- And more...

Early Decision

- 101 ED applications (including 13 EDII)
- 92 total students applied ED (32.3% of college cohort)
- 64 acceptances ED overall (63.4% admit rate ED)
- 77 ED apps to “Most Competitive” schools
 - 41 acceptances to “MC”
 - 53.3% ED admit rate to “MC”



First Generation College Students

- $n = 46$ (15.0% of class; self-reported)
- 243 applications (184 acceptances)
- **95% pursuing college**
- 25 apps to MC → 8 acceptances → 3 attend

Low-Income Students

- receive Free or Reduced lunch
- $n = 53$ (17.3% of class)
- 270 applications (193 acceptances) = 71.5% admit rate (+10%)
- 2- and 4-year college-going rate = 83%
- 27 MC apps → 6 acceptances (2 students) → 2 attending

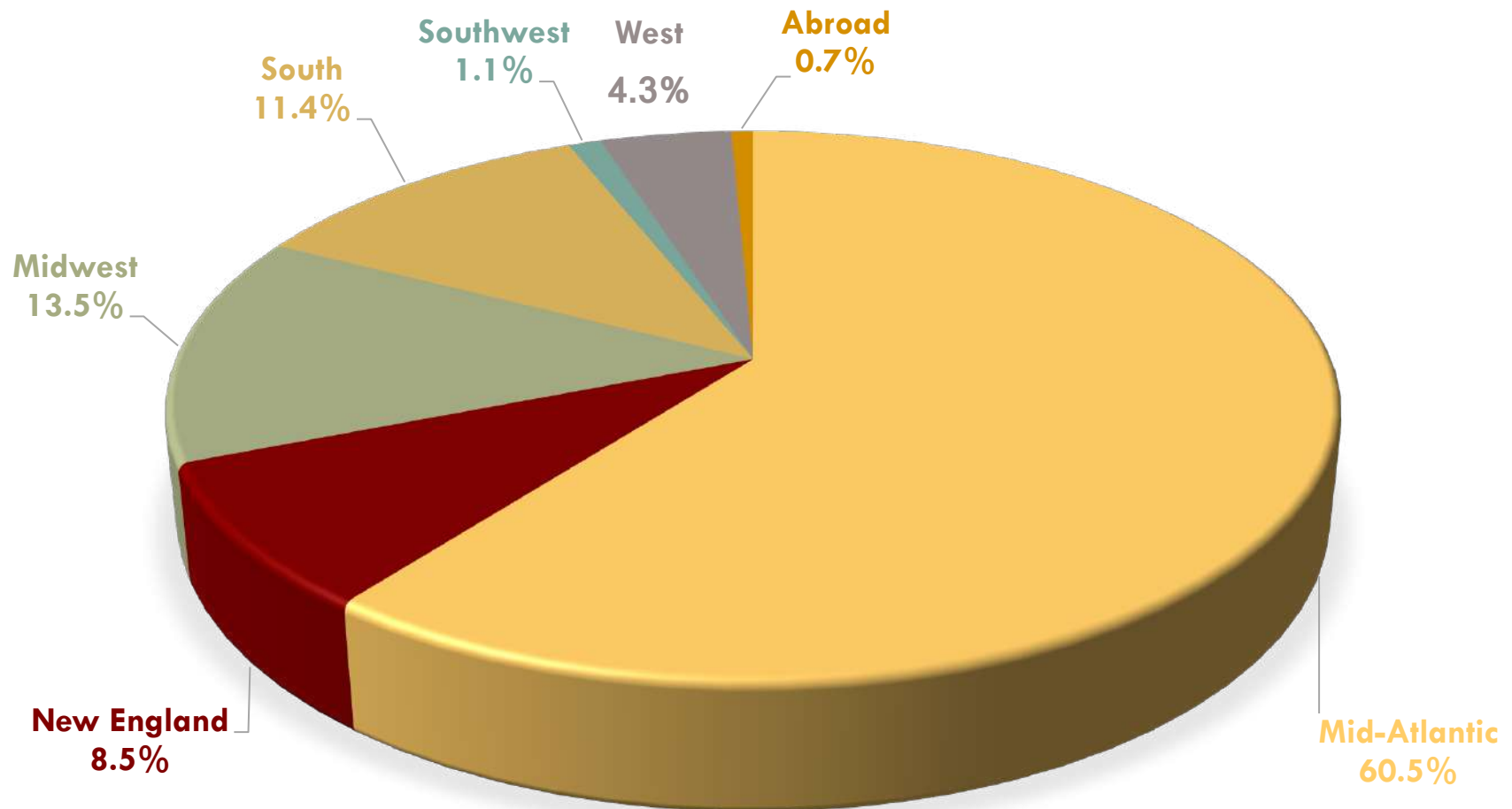
