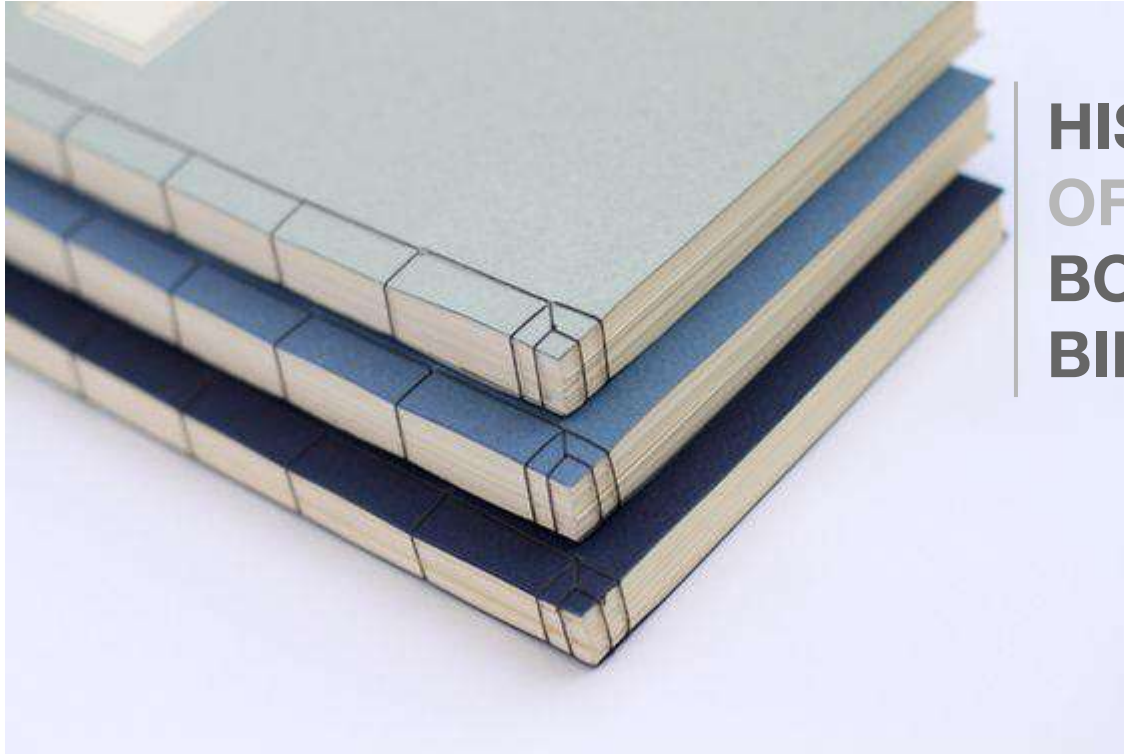


Book-binding

accordion book, saddle stitch and stab binding

“Physically assembling a book from a stack of paper sheets that are folded together. The stack is then bound together along one edge by sewing with thread or flexible adhesive.”



HISTORY OF BOOK BINDING



BEFORE 100 AD

- Clay tablets
- Long Rolls
- Papyrus
- Cloth



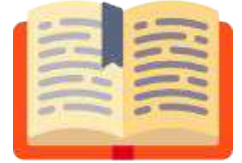
DURING FIRST CENTURY

- Sheepskin vellum
- Marks the beginning of bookbinding



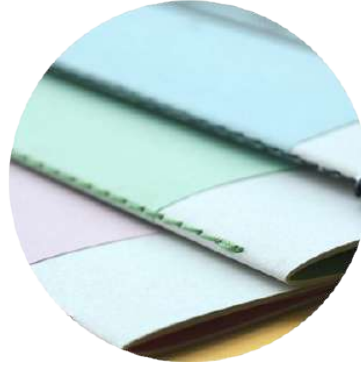
1447

TYPES OF BOOK BINDING

- **Accordion**
 - Folded structure
- **Saddle Stitch**
 - Stapled through a folded line with staple
- **Stab Binding**
 - Stitching book together using a thread



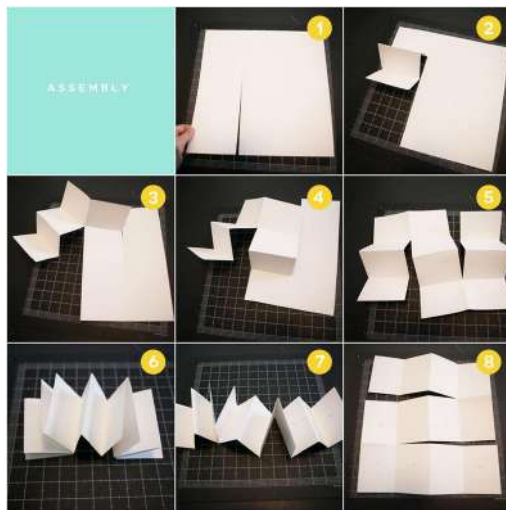
Accordion Book

ACCORDION

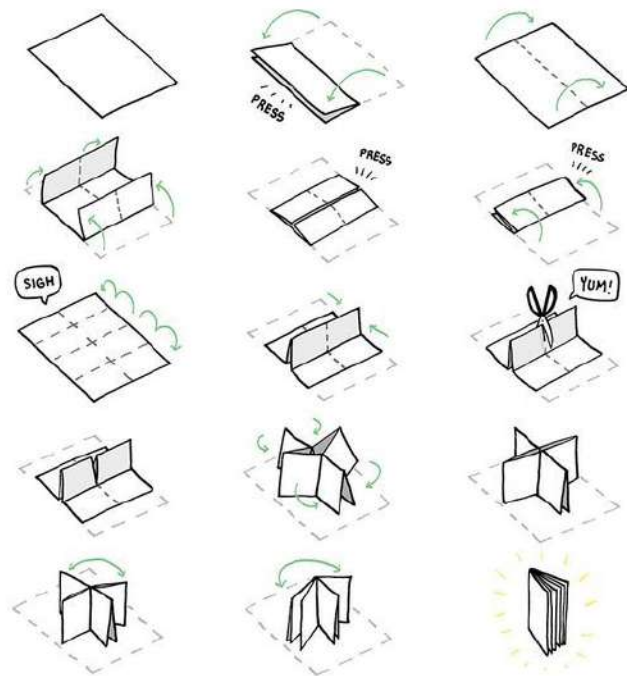


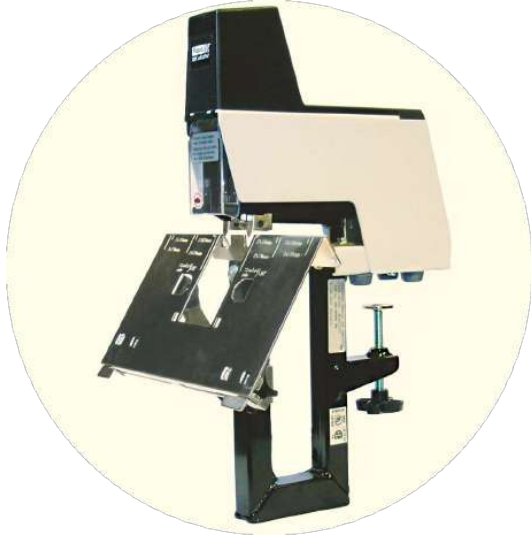
Accordion Book

in page-width increments

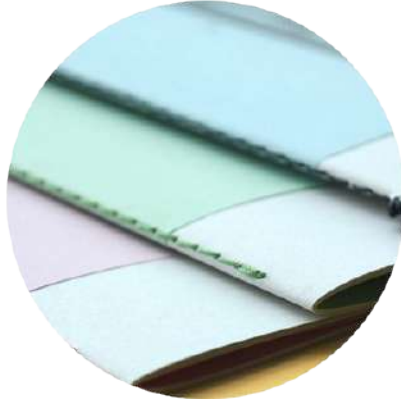


HOW TO FOLD A SHEET-O-PAPER INTO A 8-PAGE ZINE

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BASIC SEWING FOR A BOOKLET



+ RECOMMENDED sth for punching holes in the papers



but also

FOLD ALL SHEETS (including the middle), AND ALSO THE CARD/COVER



NOW PUNCH 3 HOLES THROUGH ALL-

(LIKE THIS)

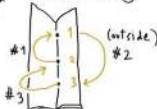


TAKE YOUR SEWING NEEDLE WITH THREAD AND START FROM OUTSIDE THROUGH HOLE ②



leave some cm, later you will make a knot

FROM THERE YOUR NEEDLE GOES NOW (INSIDE) THROUGH HOLE ①



FROM THE HOLE ① (OUTSIDE) YOU GO THROUGH HOLE ③

INSIDE, FROM HOLE ③ YOU GO THROUGH HOLE ②



NOW YOU HAVE BOTH ENDS OF THE THREAD OUTSIDE SO MAKE A KNOT OR A LACE AND YOU HAVE IT !!!



TIPS : use different colour / lined sheets for the inside, and a coloured thread or ribbon if you like the sewing enhanced.

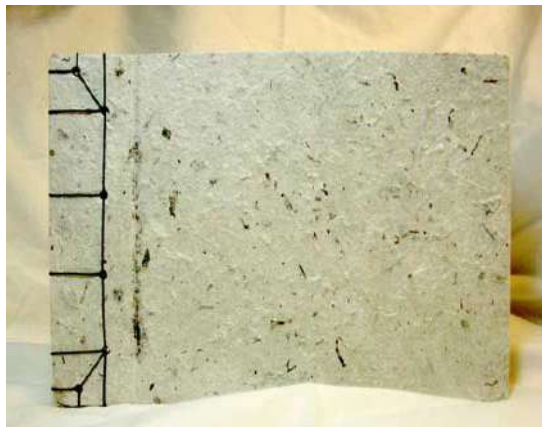

- *Kikko Toji* (Tortoise Shell Binding)



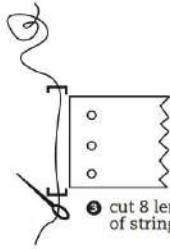

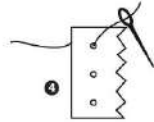
1 stack sheets and mark a straight line



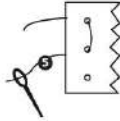
2 use hammer and nail to punch 3 holes



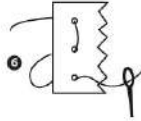
3 cut 8 lengths of string
