

**14.** <u>Color Emotion Guide:</u> When graphic designers are designing graphics, logos, business cards, etc for a business, they take into account the meaning behind colors. The next thing you will do is create a logo for BOSS on Canva using the psychology of colors. - **18.** Research a Famous Entrepreneur: Select a famous entrepreneur (Sam Walton, Oprah, Kolby Bryant, Lebron James...really is a wide open selection) and tell me who they are and what about this person that intrigues you.
- 19. <u>Bronco Chef:</u> I am not sure about you, but I cooking a lot more than I usually do and I am finding myself trying to be creative . To complete this activity, create a meal (breakfast, lunch or dinner) for your family and take a picture of the meal. Along with the pic, write a description of the dish (like you're selling it to me) so I would want to order it from the menu.
- 20. Netflix: Self Made: This is a 4 episode series on Netflix about an woman who is trying to squeeze her way into the early 1900's business world that is predominantly male. I would like you to watch the 1st episode only. (You are welcome to watch the rest of the episodes if you want, but please be aware that the last 3 episodes have some inappropriate language and scenes, so you will be watching them at your own risk.) When you are finished watching the 1st episode (about 45 minutes long), please answer the questions on the form.
- **21.** <u>Job Interview:</u> You will sit down with an adult at your house (could be a friend too if necessary), record you and your partner, and answer the following interview questions:

  - c. What did you learn from this article?
- **24.** <u>Netflix: Ray Kroc Movie</u>: You will watch the movie, Ray Kroc on Netflix. After the movie, tell me how Ray Kroc was Curious, Exploring new ways, Solving customer problems, thinking big, and selecting the right partners.
- **25.** <u>Thank you Note:</u> You will write an email to a teacher (can be K-12) and tell them what you appreciate about them. You will want to make this heart felt and specific, not a generic thank you. Please copy and paste the message in the forms.
- 26. <u>Pet Sales:</u> (Ok this is for FUN only...I don't want you to get rid of your pet!!) You're going away for a summer trip and you need someone to take care of your pet while you are gone. Sell me on taking care of them. (Ideas...show me their tricks, are they potty trained, how much time do they take, what emotional advantages do they have, etc...) You will record your sales pitch and upload it to forms.

You will upload a picture of your prototype. Please write on the picture, explain what your prototype is so it is one document.
- **28.** <u>Prime: All of the Queens Horses</u>: You will watch on Amazon Prime, All of the Queens Horses. Please explain what this documentary left you feeling like? Could this happen in our community? Explain.
