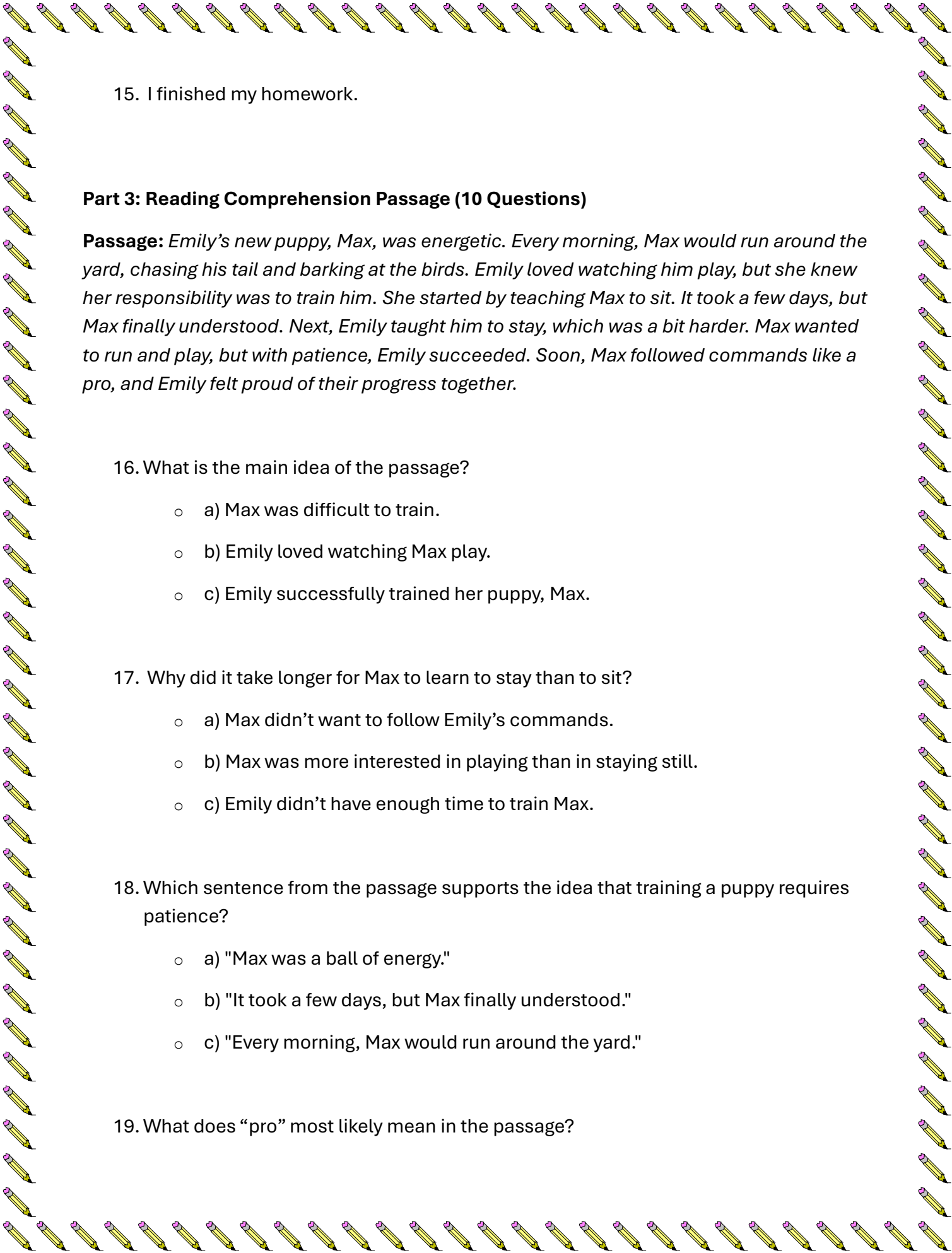
Identify the part of speech of the underlined word in each sentence.

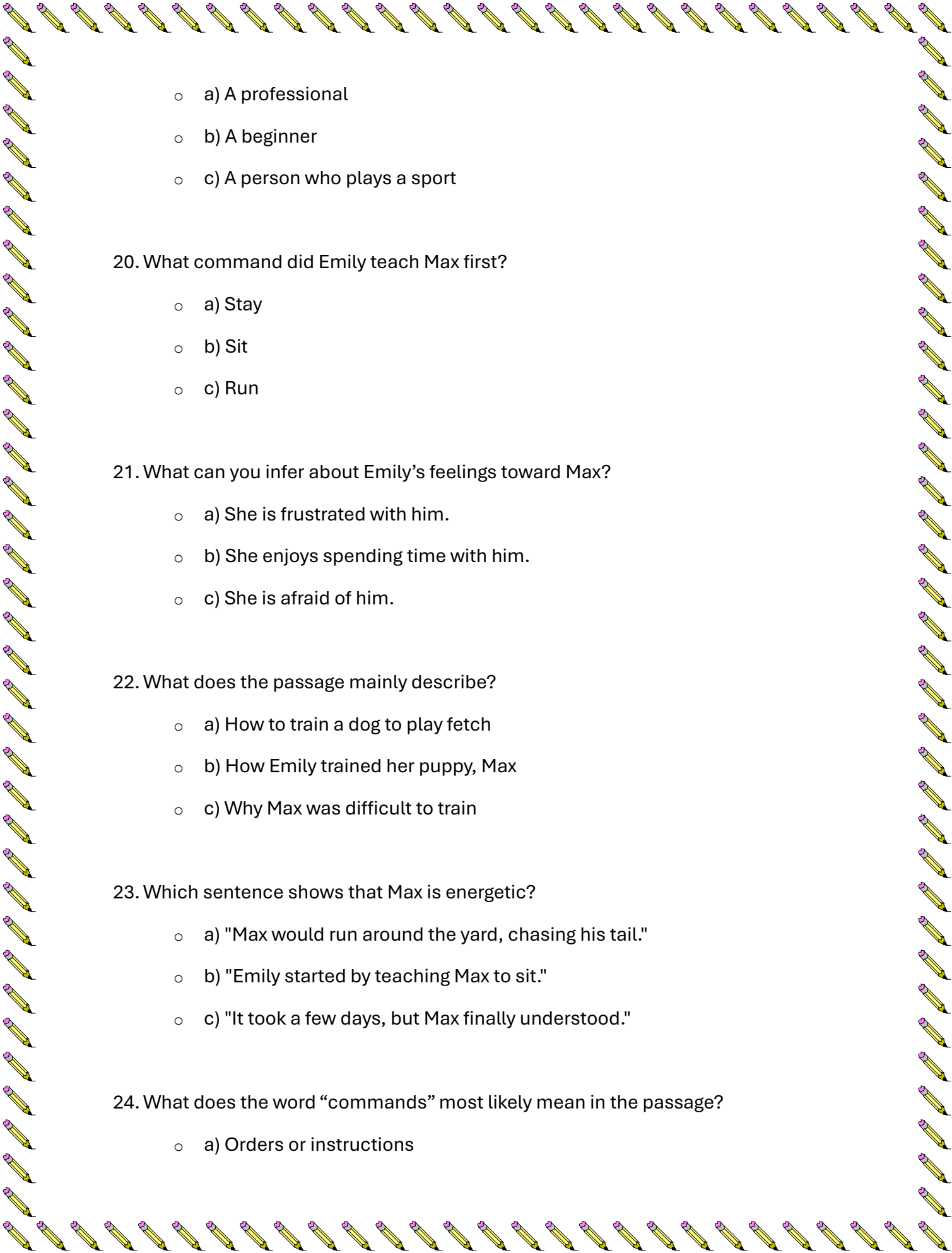

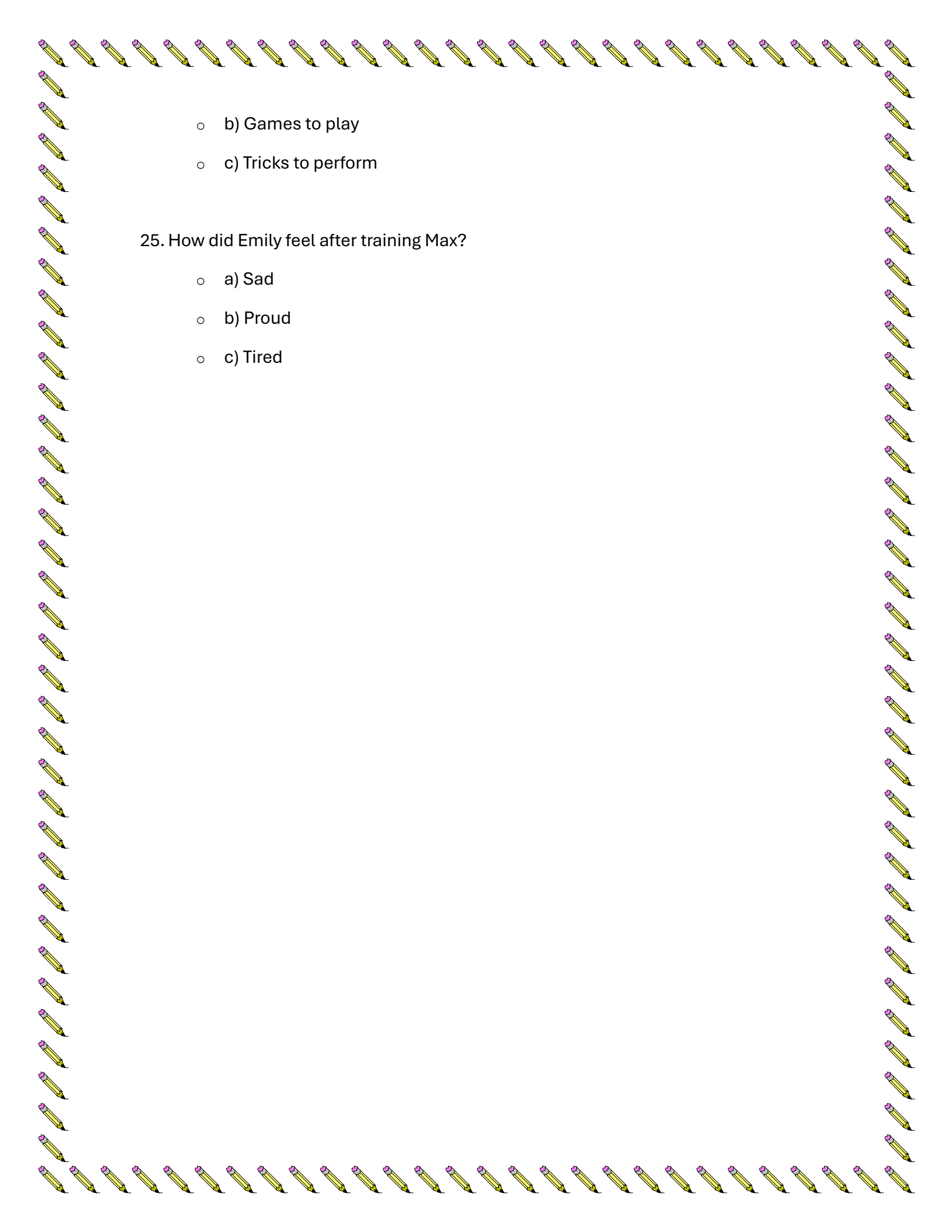
