Quickly create instructional materials, give feedback, evaluate student writing, and adjust or translate texts - all without leaving your current workspace. CREATE

Easily create Google slides, lesson plans, quizzes, and educational resources. Seamless Google Classroom integration streamlines assignment distribution.

GIVE FEEDBACK

Deliver feedback in four dynamic ways: Targeted, Glow & Grows, Rubric Criteria, and Next Steps. Targeted Feedback displays as Google comments and can guide revisions according to rubrics and standards.

The 'Feedback styles' interface shows four feedback methods: Targeted (Google Doc comments aligned to your rubric and standards), Rubric Criteria (Feedback based on each of your rubric criteria), Next steps (Suggestions for next steps and strategies to build up core skills), and Glow & Grow (Areas of strength, growth, and probing questions). INSPECT WRITING

Use 'Replay' to view the evolution of students' writing from initial draft to final version. This helps identify where to provide targeted support.
