SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- 1. Applicant must be a native of Brunswick County.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating senior with cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 3. Preference will be given to the applicant(s) who have participated in Brunswick High School from ninth through twelfth grade year programs sponsored by Brunswick County Public Schools.
- 4. Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the institution of higher education.
- 5. Applicant must have the institution of higher education send or email a letter verifying enrollment prior to release of funds (this is after classes have started).
- 6. Applicant, who has received full scholarship, including books, will not be eligible for scholarship. (Tuition, room, board, fees, and books).
- 7. Each applicant must submit an essay of 250 words or more that addresses the following statement: "As a student about to leave Brunswick High School and enter into post graduate education, what will be your most treasured memories of Brunswick Hallways during your years there and how has it impacted your tenure as you leave for new heights?
- 8. A copy of high school transcript and one letter of recommendation will be required (guidance counselor, teacher, and/or community leader but not a family member) with authentic signatures and seals.
- 9. Application must be legible that includes printed or typed script.

- 10. Application must be mailed to: Lakesha Rainey, Director of Guidance Counselor Attn: Scholarship Committee and submitted to Guidance Department no later than close of day to Brunswick High School, April 21, 2023. Scholarship application must be postmarked by April 21, 2023.
- 11. Recipient must inform the Chapter of the address of the appropriate office where funds should be mailed. This may be sent to the fore-mentioned address or School's Guidance Department.
