Greetings Brush High School Parents/Guardians-

During the month of April, Brush will begin the process of administering our state AIR assessments to students. Due to the nature of the test and the technology required to give them, students will only be able to take their AIR assessment at the physical school building.

Due to the need to provide social distancing for testing, our testing schedule will be scheduled so there will be NO MORE than 12 students testing in a designated test site. Please review the following bullet points carefully as to what this means for your child:

- Your child will **NEED** to report to school on the days that they have testing scheduled. **Please** send your child to school on days they are testing.
- If your child is not scheduled to test on a testing day, your child will follow their regular assigned scheduled **AND** asynchronous learning shall occur during the observed testing times.
- Our school day will run a normal day as not all students are testing at the same time. For those students who are remote/asynchronous on a non-testing day, they will log into Schoology and join live for their scheduled class periods.

For some, this may be the first time that your child comes to the school building for testing. If this is the case for your child, please carefully read the following bullet points:

- For students that have been remote that come for testing, we are asking that you make plans for your child to leave once the testing session is completed.
- If you are unable to pick up your child once testing is completed, your child will report to the
  Welser gym and finish their school day by following their schedule using Schoology. The
  reasoning for this is that we cannot predict how many students will come to the building for the
  first time, and it may be overwhelming for those students to try to navigate the building during
  testing not knowing where to go.
- Breakfast and Lunch will be made available to your child the day of testing.

In-person learning students will follow the same testing schedule assigned. At the conclusion of testing, students will follow their regularly scheduled classes. School work from classes missed during testing sessions will be made available for students to complete.
