An answer one of the following for the Personal Essay Section:

- Select an original work of your choice from anywhere in the world (this could be a work of art, a piece of literature, a scientific or mathematical theory, a musical composition, a film, or any other creative piece) and discuss how it has affected your thinking.
- How has your outlook on life been shaped by your hometown? In turn, how have you influenced your hometown?
- An encounter with a culture, people, or place different from your own. How did this experience affect your understanding of diversity?
- Any topic of your choice.

• Activity, Grade Level or Year of Participation, Hours per Week, Positions Held or Honors Won
