

Elementary School



- Stand Up
- Use index finger to write a large "A" in the air
- \checkmark As you are writing say out loud the number "1"
- Now write "B" in the air and say the number "2"
- Continue to write the letters in the air and say the numbers in order

Toe Tapping

Stand up and face your partner

- Both partners put out your right leg and tap your feet together one time
- ✤ As you tap your feet say "1" out loud
- Both partners put out your left leg and tap your feet together three times, while saying "3" out loud
- Tap your right feet together two times while saying "2" out loud
- Continue the 1,3,2 to tapping pattern while alternating feet.
- See how fast you can go.

Middle School

Sit Down Challenge

- Have students line up on a line
- Tell students they have to now lineup in a certain order
- Example: alphabetical order by first name or




by their birthday

Would You Rather?

- ✤ Have everyone stand face the teacher
- Teacher will ask a question and designate spots in the room for each option



Students will pick what spot they want to go

 Teacher will call on a few students to explain their answer

Ex: Would you rather be bigfoot or be lochness moster?

➢ Bigfoot stands by the door & lochness monster stands by the windows

High School

Heads Up Squeeze, Tails You Freeze

- Split class into two teams, and have them face each other
- Students hold hands and close their eyes
- Students in the front of the line can open their eyes
- The teacher will flip a coin and show the students in the front of the line



- If it is heads the students will squeeze the next person's hand, if it is tails they will stay still
- When it reaches the end, the last student in line will hit a bell or buzzer



Ultimate Thumb and Rock Paper Scissors War Students will stand up and get with a partner

 Students will play rock paper scissors war with one hand

 With their other hand students will play thumb war

Classroom

Find Your Shoe ...

- Students take off one shoe and make one big pile in the classroom, students then randomly take one shoe from the pile.
- They have 1 minute to hide the shoe around the room (must be visible).

Paper Airplanes
