Overview

BYU Independent Study is a nonprofit online educational program that offers 470+ online affordable courses—university, high school, and middle school—to students throughout the United States and in over 90 foreign countries. Enrollment is open to anyone, anytime of the year, with a full year to complete most courses with a high level of service and support for student success. BYU Independent Study students register online or by phone for a course and can start immediately. After submitting all course assignments, students can use online proctoring for most courses, or a certified proctor at the local school or in a testing center can administer the final exam.

BYU Independent Study's courses include both teacher interaction and self-paced instruction. Students access course materials online and submit all assignments electronically. The course's reading material is also available in a PDF format, but students can order a hard copy from BYU Independent Study if they want an all-inclusive readings packet. Student and technical support are available by phone, email, live chat, or mail.

Our courses are designed to be a blend of teacher interaction, media interactivity, and student-paced instruction. They include one-on-one mentoring; teacher-led activities; course orientations provided by the teachers; and meet certain state/organizational requirements for instructor interaction and student guidance. Our courses provide virtual learning supported by the use of diverse videos, computerized labs, interactive activities, instructor tutorials, and animated clips. They also include advanced features and productivity tools, including a student homepage, access to student grades, and a student progress calendar.
