

Calumet High School Graduation Requirements

A student must earn 21.5 credits to graduate from CHS

Starting with the Class of 2028, the credits required to graduate will increase to 24 credits

1 credit = full year class

0.5 credits = semester class

English:	4 credits
Math:	4 credits (one credit must be earned senior year)
Science:	3 credits (both Biology and Chemistry or Physics)
Social Studies:	3 credits (U.S. History, World History/Geography, Economics and Civics)
Health /PE:	1 credit or 0.5 credits in Health AND three years of JROTC or three years of Marching Band or three years of participation on a CHS athletic team
World Languages:	2 credits or 1 credit AND 1 additional Fine or Applied Arts
Fine or Applied Arts:	1 credit
Personal Finance:	0.5 credit
Computers:	0.5 credits
Online Learning Experience	taken as part of the class curriculum
Senior culminating project	1 credit
Electives	1.5 credits (**increases to 4 credits for class of 2028**)

All students shall participate in the Michigan Merit Examination (MME) unless excluded under the guidelines established by the State Department of Education.
