

Calypso Elementary School PTC Scholarship Application Process & Guidelines

Scholarship Description:

Calypso Elementary School's PTC will offer one \$500 scholarship to a graduating senior each school year. To be eligible to apply and receive this scholarship, you must meet all of the following criteria:

Criteria:

The applicant must...

- 1. be a graduating senior at Freedom High School or Liberty High School.
- 2. have attended Calypso Elementary School for a minimum of three full school years.
- 3. have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA throughout his/her high school career.
- 4. be attending an accredited college, university, vocational, or technical school in the Fall of his/her graduating year.

Additional Items:

The applicant must include the following items with his/her application:

- 1. copy of his/her high school transcript
- 2. two letters of recommendation from a high school teacher
- 3. a letter of recommendation from a community/school leader (scout leader, coach, instructor, minister, employer, etc.)

Application Procedure:

- 1. Applicants should complete the attached application and submit it, along with the "additional items" listed above, to the address listed on the next page.
 - 2. Applications must be received by the last day in March.
 - 3. Late and/or incomplete applications will not be accepted.
 - 4. The decision of the selection committee is final.

Selection Committee:

The selection committee will consist of the following people:

- 1. Current Calypso ES principal
- 2. Current Calypso ES guidance counselor
- 3. Two additional Calypso ES teachers of the principal's choosing

Awarding of the Scholarship:

- 1. Calypso's principal will notify the recipient by June 1.
- 2. Recipient may be invited to attend the fifth grade moving up ceremony in June to accept the award.
- 3. The \$500 scholarship check will be made payable directly to the post-high school institution.
- 4. Before the PTA will issue a check to the post-high school institution, the organization has the authority to request proof of acceptance.
