### 2015 Canon-McMillan High School Summer School Rules and Regulations

- 1. Attendance is mandatory. Students in the sixty hour courses are permitted two absences while those in physical education and health are allowed one absence. Dismissal will occur if a student surpasses these limits. No refunds will be given for dismissal.
- 2. You must be on time for school. Every two times a student is late constitutes an absence. Dismissal will occur upon the fifth late. No refunds will be given for dismissal.
- 3. No weapons, fighting, harassment, threats, theft, vandalism, or any other form of criminal behavior will be tolerated. This includes any action (including insubordination) that disrupts the classroom process. Further, the North Strabane Township Police Department will be contacted if the situation warrants this action. No refunds are given for dismissal.
- 4. The Canon-McMillan High School Dress Code is in effect. For example, tube tops, short shorts, mini-skirts, tank tops, halter tops, bathing suits, hats, other forms of head coverings, and apparel bearing inappropriate or offensive language or graphics are not permitted on campus. A more complete list will be distributed on the first day of school.
- 5. Students must remain in their assigned areas throughout the school day.
- 6. No one is permitted to leave the building for lunch.
- 7. Parking rules and adherence to municipal motor vehicle regulations are mandatory.
- 8. No food or beverages are permitted in the classroom area.
- 9. No cell phones, iPods, or other forms of electronic devices are permitted in the classroom areas.
- 10.Possession of drugs, alcohol, tobacco and related materials is cause for immediate dismissal and notification of the North Strabane Township Police Department. No refunds will be given for dismissal.
- 11.The Canon-McMillan School District is not responsible for any lost and/or stolen items.
