

Canvas Help Sheet

To access your child's Canvas account, you will need to have him/her log-on. The following screenshots will help orient you.

For freshmen, you should see four courses and ECHS Home.

For sophomores, you should see three courses and ECHS Home.

View from DASHBOARD:



From this view (or other teacher/course pages), you will be able to use the navigation buttons on the left to access MODULES, FILES, ASSIGNMENTS, INBOX and others. On the right side, you will notice that the TO DO and COMING UP heading shows assignments posted in blue and can be clicked on for specific information. Individualized links may also appear on the page. (Teacher home pages will vary in appearance.)

View from a MODULE:



Some teachers will use modules to post in-class work, homework, reminders, etc. The arrangement of the module screen above can vary in appearance by teacher (daily, weekly, or by units of study). The screen above is arranged by week, and a pull down list of days will appear by clicking on the week.

Notice that you may navigate back to the home screen or other links. These are just a few of the page views available in Canvas to help you get started.
