2020-21 School Re-Entry Frequently Asked Questions

1. When will student schedules be ready? They are completed and can be viewed in Schoology on Monday, September 7, 2020. If you have scheduling concerns or questions, please contact your child's counselor.
2. What happens if Kanawha County remains in the orange on the WVDHHR County Alert System map on Saturday at 9:00 PM? The entire county will start the school year on Remote Instruction for at least one week. The map will be updated every Saturday at 9:00 PM. This means that all students will remain at home for Remote Instruction until we move out of the orange. If this is the case, we will follow our A/B schedule. On Tuesday, September 8th would be A-Day and students will log-in to Schoology and complete assignments for classes 1,3,5, and 7. Wednesday, September 9 would be B-Day and students would log-in to Schoology and complete course work for periods 2,4,6, and 8.
3. What happens if Kanawha County moves from orange to yellow on the WVDHHR County Alert System? This means that Face-to-Face Instruction will resume and we will follow the KCS RE-Entry Plan listed on the KCS website.
4. How do I monitor County Alert System which impacts the status of school and athletics? You need to visit the following website and click on County Alert System:

5. What time are face-to-face students permitted on campus? Our doors will be unlocked for students at 8:00 AM on Tuesday morning.
6. What time does the tardy bell ring? 9:25. Students may enter their first period class as early as 9:15, but no later than 9:25 (without being marked tardy).
7. If students arrive on campus between 8:00 AM-9:15 AM, where do they wait? Students will wait in the cafeteria/commons and courtyard.
8. How are student dropped off in the morning? Parents should drop their students off on the sidewalk in front of the arch. The loop is reserved for bus drop-off. This is the only location for student drop-off. Parents **are not** permitted to drop-off on the north (Charleston) side of the building or behind the building.
9. What time does the Carver bus leave? The Carver bus will depart from CHS at 9:15 AM.
10. How will students be dismissed at the end of the day? We will operate on a staggered dismissal. Car Riders and Drivers will be dismissed first. After that each bus will be called to the bus loop upon its arrival on campus. Our goal is to have everyone dismissed and on their way home by 4:00 PM.
11. How do students log-in to Schoology? Directions for logging into Schoology are available on the Capital High School website. Directions have also been shared on Facebook. There are also directions and videos posted on the Kanawha county Schools website under the Re-Entry 2020 tab. You will need to go the bottom and click on Schoology and Technology Guide. 13. What happens if my student does not have an iPad? Students in need of an iPad should call Capital High School at (304) 348-6500 and ask for Mr. Lilly. Mr. Lilly will schedule to be able to assist you with your iPad requests. Please note that students with iPad obligations from previous years will need to make payment arrangements.
