
Several Casey families gathered at the school on Thursday, September 27, for the annual "Make and Take Night." Volume 17 Issue 1 October 2018

drew self-portraits with a single line, a skill that is important in preparing students to draw lines to make other images and symbols, like letters and numbers.




Part of the study of "Junkyard Wonders" includes discussions of character traits. In the Art classroom, third graders identified the character traits they saw in figures in famous paintings.

Shakespeare's Twelfth Night

Fifth graders have spent the first nine weeks reading and preparing to perform their version of Shakespeare's comedy *Twelfth Night*.

They first read the play with Ms. Trotter and Mr. Howell. When they were assigned character roles, they began to learn their lines and to think about how to bring these characters to life. In Ms. Walker's class, they have created self-portraits of the characters, learning details of how to draw the correct proportions for facial features.









In Drama Class, the students rehearse their parts over and over, learning to work together to tell the story.
