

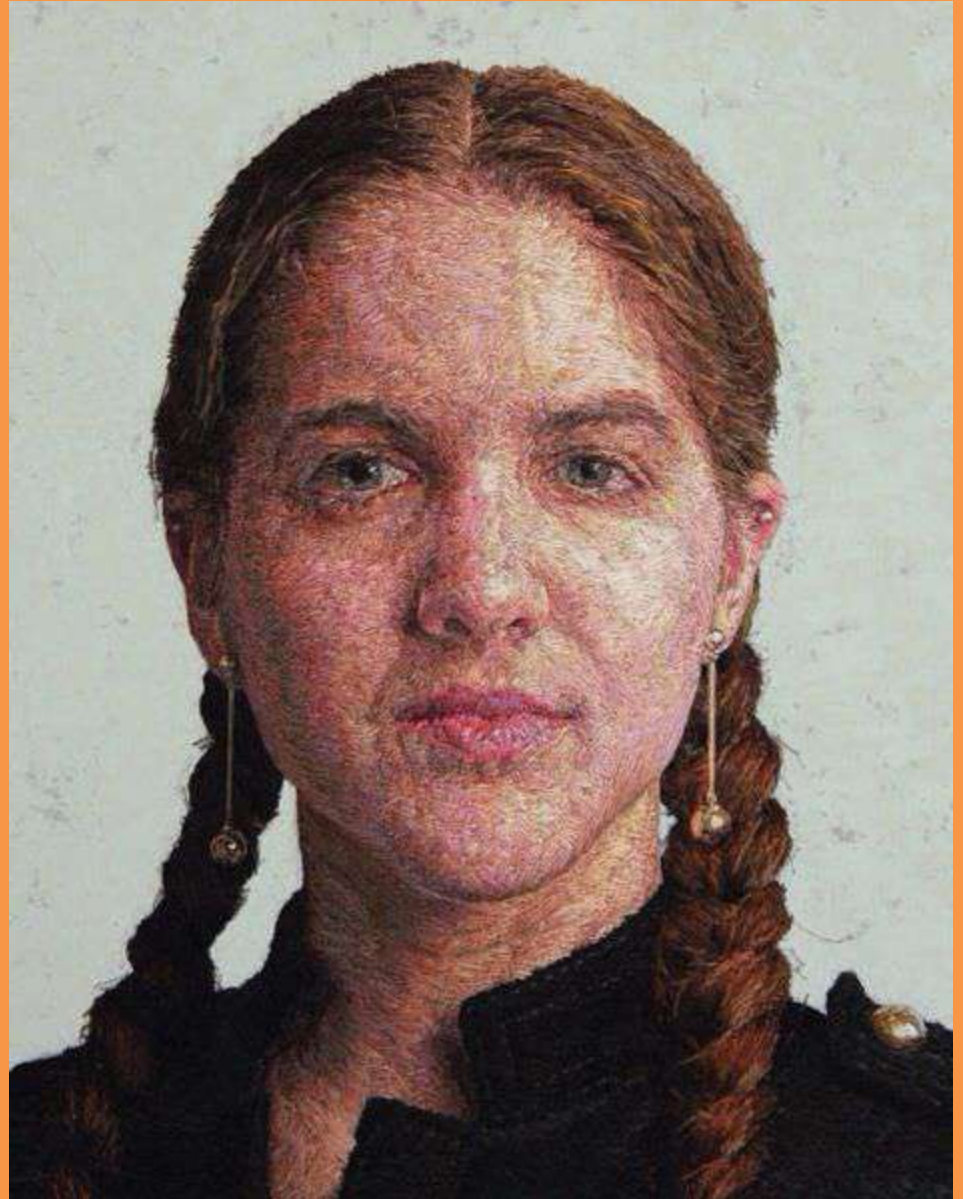
# Today's Artist: Cayce Zavaglia
