CCART 15th Anniversary Art Scholarship Requirements & Guidelines

CCART is a non-profit organization in support of the visual arts. The primary goal is to provide scholarships to talented high school seniors residing on the Lower Eastern Shore of Delaware, Maryland and Virginia seeking continued education to the school of choice in the study of visual arts. Scholarships and awards have ranged from \$500 to \$2,000; 7,000 in scholarships were awarded in 2014. Scholarships will be awarded during the second semester as long as the recipient is in good academic standing.

ELIGIBILITY

- Eastern Shore (Maryland: Caroline, Dorchester, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico, & Worcester; Delaware: Sussex; Virginia: Accomack & Northampton) high school seniors planning on majoring in visual arts.
- High school transcript: 2.5 average or higher.
- Evidence of application to a university, 2 or 4 year college or other programs that lead to the study of visual arts.

If original three-dimensional works are unavailable, photographic examples could be submitted in three-dimensional views (sides and top), no less than 5" x 7" color photographs, or other means of viewing such as DVD video or computer disk/CD. Please provide your own laptop for viewing CD/DVD.

DEADLINE for Student Personal Information Form, transcript and recommendation letters is Friday, APRIL 3, 2015, by 5:00 p.m. Applications <u>must</u> be received by this deadline. These forms should be mailed to: CCART, P. O. BOX 4194, SALISBURY, MD 21803-4194.

PORTFOLIO AND INTERVIEW SCHEDULE (LOCATION TBA)

CCART will review Student Personal Information Forms. Students will then be notified by phone of the time & location for their individual interview and portfolio review.
