### Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- \* Seeking graduating seniors continuing their education in a technical field.
- \* Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.0, participate in both school and community activities and plan to attend a South Dakota technical school.
- \* Scholarship funds will be paid ***upon enrollment directly to the school*** at the beginning of the second semester and not to the student.
- \* Applicants must be willing to interview with the CCR MC selection panel to be considered for the scholarship.
