Dear Parent/Guardian:

Please be prepared to provide to the school an up-to-date <u>proof of immunization</u> and/or <u>health assessment</u> for your child on the <u>first day of school</u>. After 30 calendar days, from the first day of school, the principal shall not permit the child to attend school until the required proof of immunization and/or health assessment is provided.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS (new July 1, 2015)

Below is a basic guide of the immunizations required for school entry. For complete information, please visit www.immunize.nc.gov.

DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus and acellular pertussis)

5 doses (if 4th dose after 4th birthday, 5th dose not required)

4 doses (if 3rd dose after 4th birthday, 4th dose not required)

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)2 dosesHepatitis B (Hep B)3 dosesVaricella (chickenpox)2 doses

Hib (Haemophilus Influenzae type B)

Pneumococcal conjugate (PCV)

3-4 doses (not required after age 5)

4 doses (not required after age 5)

Students entering 7th grade or by 12 years of age, are required to have:

Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) 1 dose
Meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV) 1 dose

Beginning August 1, 2020 a booster dose (MCV) is required for students entering 12^{th} grade or 17 years of age

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HEALTH ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENTS (new 16-17)

Every child in North Carolina public schools, entering <u>Kindergarten</u> or a <u>higher grade for the first time</u> are required to submit proof of a health assessment (completed within 12 months of the first day of school).

The 30 day deadline is September 10, 2019 .
