Program Overview

Award Amount: Awards will be up to \$3,000.

Note: The number and dollar amount of loan repayment applications funded will depend on available funds, number of applications submitted, and quality of application requests.

Applicant Eligibility:

Calvert County Public Schools employees who graduated from a Calvert County high school and were hired as a new employee for the 2023-2024 school year are eligible to apply.

Essay Requirements:

The essay should be between 250-500 words.

Essay Question: "I became an educator because...and as an educator in Calvert County I hope to..."

Important Dates:

- Applications will be accepted from September 1, 2023, through June 1, 2024.
- Applications are reviewed monthly.
- Notification of winning applicants will occur by June 30, 2024.
