What is a Scientific Explanation?

Claim

Evidence

Reasoning

How do you know that? What do you know? Claim + Evidence + Reasoning = Explanation Why does your evidence support your claim?

Claim:

A statement that answers your question

Evidence for your claim:

- Scientific data that support the claim
- Data need to be appropriate (pictures, graphs, table)
- Observation

Reasoning (how your evidence justifies your claim):


- Based on scientific principles
- Each piece of evidence may have a different justification for why it supports the claim
