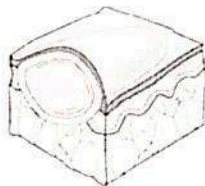

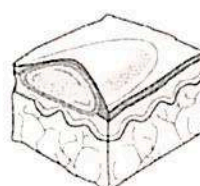
A 12.91 is a closed sack or pouch containing fluid or semisolid material.



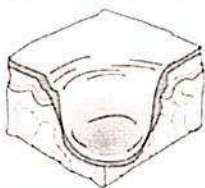
A 12.92 is a small circumscribed elevation of the skin containing pus.
