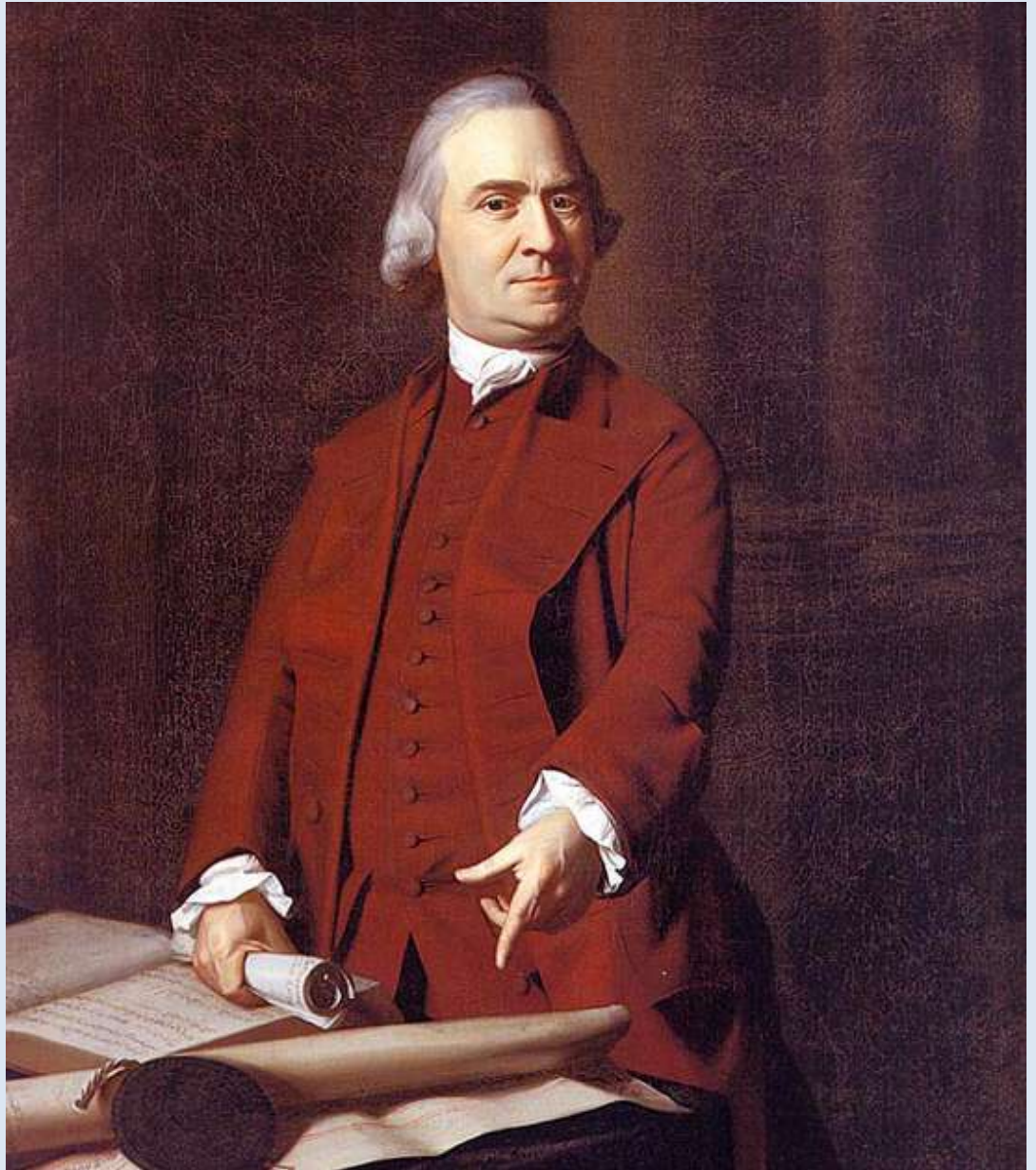

Boston Massacre

Conflict between colonists and British Soldiers in which five colonists were killed.



John Adams

A cousin of Samuel Adams and a lawyer who defended the British soldiers involved in the Boston Massacre.



Committee of Correspondence

A group that exchanged letters on colonial affairs with similar groups



Boston Tea Party

Protest against the Tea Act in which colonists dumped British tea into Boston Harbor.
