
# Which definition best describes a word root?

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**Rule 1 states that a suffix links to a word root if it begins with a vowel, which word is not linked correctly according to rule 1.**





**Rule 2 states that a vowel must be inserted between a word root and a suffix if the suffix begins with a consonant. Which word is NOT linked correctly according to rule 2?**





**Rule 3 states that a vowel links a root to another when forming compound medical words. Which word is NOT linking roots correctly according to rule 3?**
