NUCLEOSOME -

Beadlike structure formed by coiling DNA around histone proteins that pack together to form chromosomes

REPRESSOR -

molecule that binds to the operator region of an operon and "turns the gene off"

ANTI-PARALLEL-

Orientation in which the two complementary strands in a DNA molecule run in opposite directions

TRANSPOSON-

Sequence of DNA that can jump from one location to another which is thought to be involved in increasing mutations in cells
