#### There are **3 level** of government in the United States

- 1. Local government- includes village, town, city, and county governments
- 2. State governments- set up by the people of each state
- 3. National government- the government for our entire nation

#### There are **3 branches** of Government in the United States

- 1. Legislative Branch- Makes our nations laws (congress)
- Executive Branch- Enforces our nation's laws (President is the head)
- 3. Judicial Branch- In charge of interpreting our nation's laws (judges in the Supreme Court)
