1. **cataracts** - dangerous, fast-moving waters
2. **delta** - a fan-shaped area of marshy land near where a river flows into the sea
3. **shadoof** - a bucket attached to a long pole, used to move water for irrigation
4. **papyrus** - a reed plant that grows along the Nile River
5. **hieroglyphics** - a writing system made up of picture and sound symbols
6. **dynasty** - a line of rulers from one family
7. **theocracy** - a government in which the same person is the political and religious leader
8. **pharaoh** - ruler of ancient Egypt
9. **bureaucrat** - government official
10. **embalming** - the process of preserving dead bodies
11. **pyramid** - a great stone tomb built for an Egyptian pharaoh
12. **incense** - a material burned for its pleasant smell
13. **envoy** - a person who represents his country in a foreign place
14. **savanna** - a flat grassland, sometimes with scattered trees, in a tropical or subtropical region
15. **textile** - woven cloth
