Chapter 9 Geography definitions

<u>relative location-</u> the location of a place relative to other places. (when you use another place as a landmark to find a particular place.)

<u>physical characteristics</u> natural parts of the land, like rivers, lakes, or mountains

human characteristics— things that people have added to a place, like a town, road, or school. Human characteristics also include political boundaries, such as city and state borders.

<u>cardinal directions</u> - main directions of north, south, east and west on a compass

<u>intermediate directions</u> - directions between the cardinal directions on a compass (northeast, southeast, northwest, southwest)

<u>compass rose</u> - a small drawing on a map that shows directions.

<u>map scale</u> - shows the relationship between distances on a map and real distances.
