Due Date:

- 1. You will need to design a **simple** character and sketch it out onto drawing paper, supplied by me.
- 2. You will need to draw your character in three different positions: front view, side view and back view. PLEASE keep the paper horizontal; it will fit the three views better. Begin your sketches towards the top to leave room for attaching the brief description (see #4).
- 3. You will need to color your character with colored pencils, supplied by me.
- 4. You will need to type a brief description about your character. The things to include in this description are:
 - a. Give your character a name
 - b. Describe what type of emotion your character displays, you can use more than one emotion, but you should describe the ways in which your character looks when the emotions change.
 - c. Describe what your character looks like, for example, if he has eight arms describe what they are used for or if she has suction cups on the top of her head explain why.
 - d. You should type up the description in Microsoft Word in a 12 sized font of your choice (as long as it is easy to read) and please use single spacing because you will need to cut out your description and attach it to your finished sketches.
- 5. Ask to see my example if you are still not clear as to what is expected.

REMEMBER; keep your design simple, not too much detail. Trust me on this one! If later on after you feel more comfortable you can go back and add more details to your character but for now start off simple. **EXAMPLE BELOW:**
