Top5 Community Questions

QUESTION 1: Am I voting for one new school for Chariho elementary students in the April 6, 2021 vote on the budget?

ANSWER: No.

QUESTION 2: Am I voting for any new school plans for Chariho in the April 6, 2021 vote?

ANSWER: No.

QUESTION 3: How much money is being allocated in the budget we are voting for on April 6, 2021 to pursue new elementary school options?

ANSWER: \$250,000 has been allocated to pay for the requirements to pursue the feasibility of multiple options to reimagine our elementary schools. This includes money for the architects to design and redesign based on feedback.

QUESTION 4: When will the community/taxpayer vote on a possible elementary school plan?

ANSWER: Next year, during the April 2022 budget referendum.

QUESTION 5: Is the school committee going to stick with Option A moving forward, which is to build 1 large elementary school?

ANSWER: The school committee has Option A as a starting point. Over the next 4-5 months there will be sessions to listen to community feedback and determine the best plan moving forward. That may be Option A or an option that takes a completely new direction. No final decisions have been made and we must have community input on our next steps.
