I'm in our Rhapsody Choir, I love singing, performing, and really anything that has to do with music.






## McKenna Fisher - Class of 2021 - Lucy Van Pelt

## Mackenzie Macko - Class of 2021 - Sally Brown



Daniel is a Junior at Woodridge who has been involved in theater for over 5 years. This is is third show at Woodridge, and he is playing the role of Woodstock.




## Alex Bentley - Class of 2021 - Crew

#### Steven A. Miller - Musical Director


