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COMMUNITY OUTREACH CHILD FIND

It is the responsibility of the Avon Public Schools to identify any child who may have a disability either who is a resident of Avon or who attends a private school within the geographic boundaries of Avon even if the student is not a resident of Avon.

This also includes students who are Homeschooled, or in Private Preschools or Day Care settings. Avon Public Schools are also responsible for the evaluation of those students to determine if they are eligible for special education or related services under Federal law, IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act) or, Massachusetts State Law, 603 CMR 28 (Massachusetts Special Education Regulations).

Avon Public Schools is also committed to identifying children before their third birthday in order to provide early intervention services for three and four year-olds with disabilities. If you have questions or concerns regarding your child's development and would like to have him/her screened, please call our office at 508-588-0230 to set up an appointment. If you suspect that your child or a child you are aware of in Avon may need an evaluation to determine eligibility for special education services, you (parent) may request an evaluation, at no cost, through the Avon Public Schools Central Office.
