If they are not at grade level we strive to help them have above average growth each year through our Intervention program. We monitor all Chokio-Alberta Public Schools students in Reading and Math with an assessment called STAR 360. Using our established Intervention system to identify struggling reading and math students for kindergarten through 8th graders, provide the proper interventions needed for those struggling students, and monitor the struggling students' progress will close the achievement gap.
