## CHRISTMAS AROUND THE WORLD

Let's combine learning with Christmas! Each student and their partner will create an ornament representing a different CULTURE and RELIGION. You will make ornaments. One depicting your chosen CULTURE, one that depicts the primary RELIGION of that culture, and one with the culture's flag from the country of origin you have chosen.



## Directions:

- 1. Each ornament should be made out of cardboard, cardstock, or construction paper. They should be real pictures, drawings, or depictions of the culture or religion.
- 2. The ornament needs to be approximately 6x6 in size.
- 3. The attached paper needs to be turned in with your ornament.
