- 1. **Go to** https://ciits.kyschools.us (you might want to bookmark this site for future use)
- 2. **Sign in** with the following credentials:

- 4. In the **Find Standards and Materials** box on the homepage (circled in red above), **select the grade and subject** you are looking for from the dropdown menus. **Select Standards or Materials** for your search. **Click go.**
- 5. **Click on the domain/strand name** to see the full standard.




6. In the resources column, click on the number for the standard you wish to explore.
