

# Cinema Palette Painting

Watercolor paper, 9" by 12"

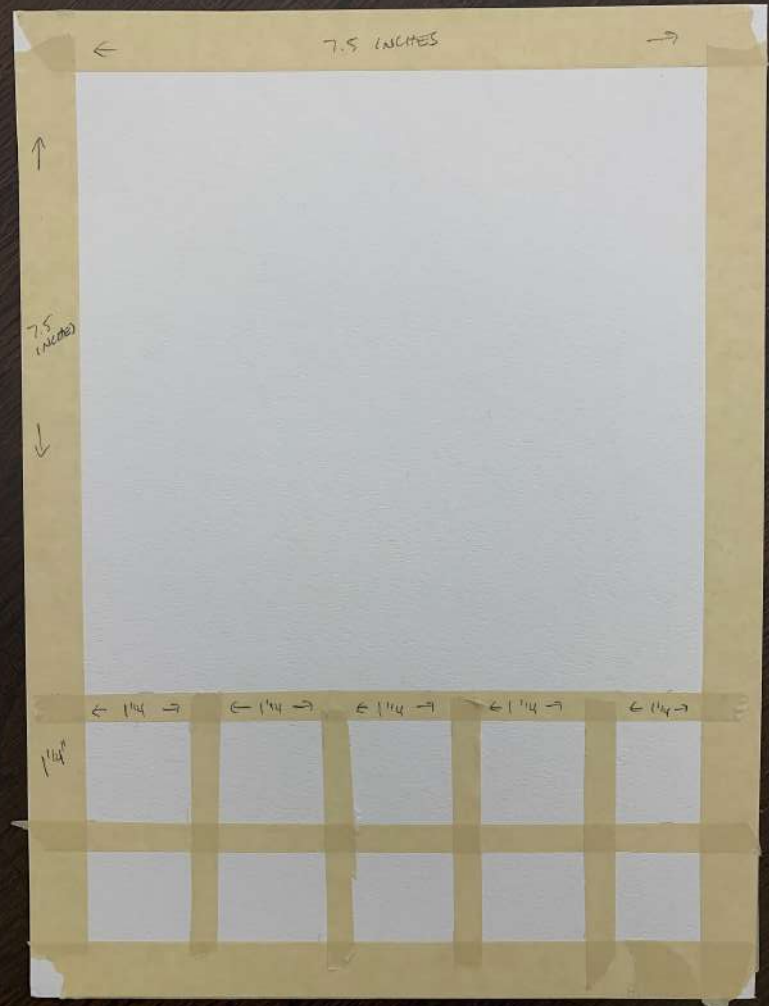
Tape a border around the entire edge.

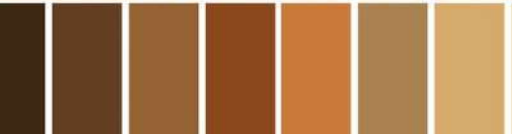
Measure FROM THE INSIDE OF THE TAPE LINE 7.5" down (make a mark on both sides) and make a tape line (BUT! Cut this piece of tape in half lengthwise).

Measure down 1  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from inside the tape line, add another half masking tape strip.

Measure from inside the left tape edge 1  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", place a half tape line.

Continue across the bottom until you have 5 squares, each 1  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide.





Choose your favorite series or movie director and watch a favorite episode/movie, looking for your favorite scene. Take a screen shot of this. Note: you should crop this to a square format to match our dimensions.

Draw this image out lightly in pencil in the upper box of your paper, then choose 10 of the “key” colors in this scene to create in the lower squares.

You will then paint the upper scene, trying to match your colors accurately.
