What is the name of the database?

How are you viewing this article? Print? Web? CD?

What date did you look at the information?

## How to set up an online database citation

Author(s). "Title of Article." *Title of Magazine, etc* Day Month Year of Publication: pages.

Database Name. Medium of Publication. Day Month Year of Access.

## How to set up an online database citation for a scholarly journal

**Scholarly journal:** Notice the volume number, issue number, and year in parenthesis.

Author(s). "Title of Article." *Title of Journal* Volume. Issue (year): pages.

\*Database Name. Medium of Publication. Day Month Year of Access.
