Civil War Timeline: 1860-1865

1860

- November Lincoln elected President
- December South Carolina leaves the Union

February, 1861

• Confederacy is formed (SC, GA, Alabama, TX, FL, Mississippi, Louisiana) and Jefferson Davis is elected President of the Confederacy.

April through May, 1861

- April Ft. Sumter is attacked Civil War begins
- April through May 4 more states join the Confederacy (VA, NC, Arkansas, Tennessee)

July, 1861

- First Battle of Bull Run
- The North heads toward Richmond but is turned back
- Stonewall Jackson gets his nickname here

April, 1862

- Battle of Shiloh
- Union Army is not able to permanently divide the South in two

August, 1862

• Second Battle of Bull Run – The North is still not any closer to Richmond.

September, 1862

- Battle of Antietam
- Single, bloodiest day in American History
- South loses ¼ of its troops
- Lincoln fires McClellan because he did not follow the South

January, 1863

- Emancipation Proclamation takes effect
- May Battle of Chancellorsville and the Battle of Vicksburg begins
- July Battle of Gettysburg and the end of the Battle of Vicksburg

November, 1863

• Lincoln's Gettysburg Address

September – December 1864

- Sherman's famous "March to the Sea"
- Atlanta to Savannah
- After December, Sherman heads North to help Grant May 1864 – April 1865
- Battleground: Virginia
- Grant takes on Lee
- April 2, 1865 Union Army gains Richmond
- April 9, 1865 Lee surrenders at Appomattox Courthouse (VA)
