Make a SunPrint

Supplies:

1. Your 10 or more themed objects
2. Constitution paper or some other kind of colored paper (maybe colored page from the newspaper or wrapping paper, if you have none of these check your mail for some junk mail with color)
3. Cling wrap/plastic wrap, plexi glass or rocks to hold down your objects from the wind.

4. Sunlight - set your objects out on the paper for 4 hours to get the best results - take a picture of your stuff out in the sun.
5. Take a picture of your final SunPrint and upload to classroom
