
Character at HDMS

Cell Phone Policy

Reporting unkind/unsafe behavior... Stop, Walk, and Talk!

Report unkind behavior when:

- You have (kindly but firmly) told the person to stop & it continues
- Another student's behavior is harming you or someone else
- Another student's behavior is affecting your learning
- Another student's behavior is threatening

Report to school staff member when:

- The unkindness happened on campus or the bus
- The unkindness continues after you initially reported it

Report to your parents and/or police:

- The unkindness happened via technology and/or off campus
- The unkindness continues after you initially reported it

Reporting unkind/unsafe behavior...

<u>Snitch</u>: Someone who was involved in a crime and then "sells out" their criminal partners to gain a lesser consequence

Students who report unkind/unsafe behavior that may cause them or someone else harm are **NOT** being a "snitch."

The names of reporting students (who may or may not be involved in the situation) will always be kept confidential.

AS A MEMBER OF OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY, WE EXPECT YOU TO <u>ALWAYS</u> REPORT UNSAFE OR UNKIND BEHAVIOR TO ENSURE OUR SCHOOL IS A POSITIVE AND SAFE PLACE FOR <u>ALL STUDENTS</u>!!!!!

8th Grade Party Criteria

Our goal is that every 8th-grade student be able to participate fully in our end-of-year activities like the 8th Grade Party. Some student behaviors may exclude a student from participating in end of year events.
