

THE CURRICULUM

King George High School operates on a 4 X 4 block schedule and has a comprehensive program of study for all students. Students benefit from an active Naval Science ROTC program and the school serves as a satellite location for Rappahannock Community College. Students also have the opportunity to participate in the Chesapeake Bay Governor's School for Marine and Environmental Science which provides students the opportunity to explore connections among the environment, math, science and technology curriculums. The Commonwealth Governor's School is a challenging, interdisciplinary college preparatory program. Governor's School classes are year-long and student's final grades appear in the second semester.
